## **The Architect - Carlos Ott**

Carlos Ott is one of the world's leading architects with more than 35 years of experience. Winner of many international awards, Mr Ott has left his indelible architectural impression in all corners of the globe, from the Opera de la Bastille in Paris, France, to the International Airport Lago Argentino in Provincia de Santa Cruz, Argentina, to the Beijing Opera House in Beijing, China, to the Sunny Isles Residences Complex in Miami, Florida, U.S. The recent launch of his first architectural masterpiece in Singapore, One Shenton, was met with resounding success.

He designs with multiple perspectives in mind, looking through the eyes of architect, buyer, developer and marketer interchangeably.
