THE CDL GROUP OF COMPANIES PUT UP A RESOUNDING SHOW OF SUPPORT AT THE ASSISI HOSPICE CHARITY FUN DAY 2008

The CFD is organised by Assisi Hospice and co-organised by City Developments Limited (CDL) and its subsidiary, CBM Pte Ltd. CDL has also rallied its five Singapore hotels to participate at this event.

The CDL Group of Companies has sponsored some 37-metres of food and games stalls that promises a feast for the senses and a treat of thrilling experience for patrons, young and old alike.
